Level	Subdivision I & II	Qualification Requirements
General Information	Handlers may compete in subdivision I & II simultaneously in the same trial.	<p>All dogs may compete in higher division(s) simultaneously at the same trial. However, qualifying scores at the higher level will only be granted if the same exercise has been completed towards a title in the lower level.</p> <p>For example, a dog entering Rookie I has 2Qs for exercise 1,2 and 4. The dog may enter Elite I. If they pass exercises 1 and 2, these Elite qualifiers will only count if the dog qualifies in exercise 1 and 2 at the same trial.</p> <p>It is therefore possible for a dog to be working in all three levels at the same time.</p> <p>An exercise is completed towards a title when it has been Passed three times under two judges.</p>
Rookie	May compete in Rookie I and Rookie II simultaneously in the same trial.	Must have a WPT title or and Advanced title to enter either subdivisions of Rookie
Elite	May compete in Elite I and Elite II simultaneously at the same trial	<p>Qualifying scores at the Elite level will only be granted if the same exercise has been completed for a title in Rookie level at the same trial or prior to.</p> <p>May be competing in Rookie or Expert levels concurrently.</p>
Expert	May compete in Expert I and Expert II simultaneously at the same trial	<p>Qualifying scores at the Expert level will only be granted if the same exercise has been completed for a title in Elite level at the same trial or prior to.</p> <p>May be competing in Rookie or Elite levels concurrently.</p>
